Figure 1: HIV notifications by jurisdiction, 2013 – 2022

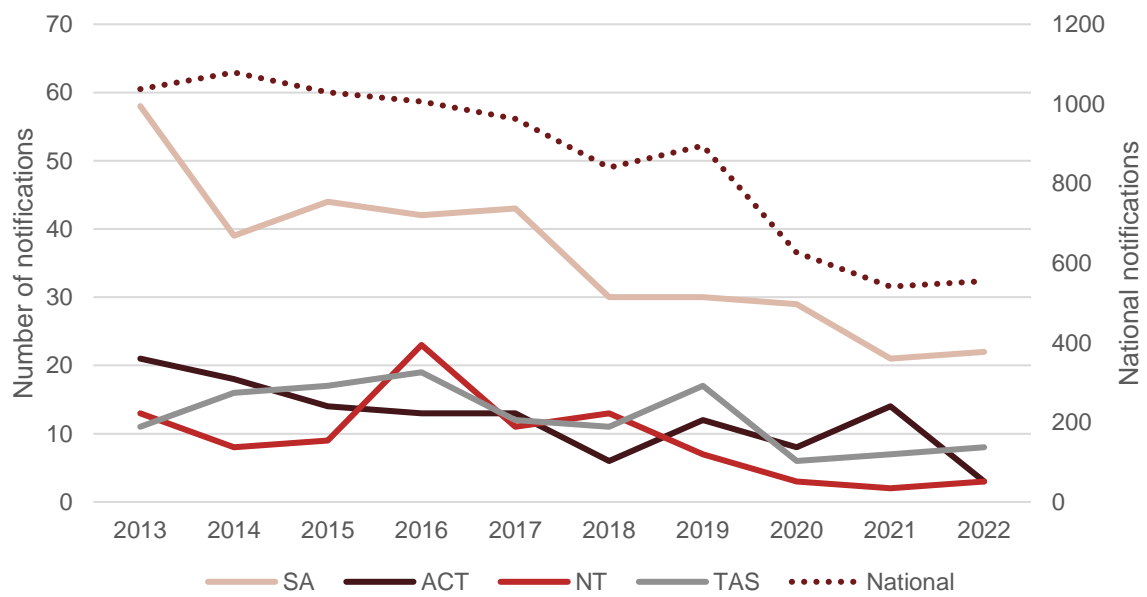
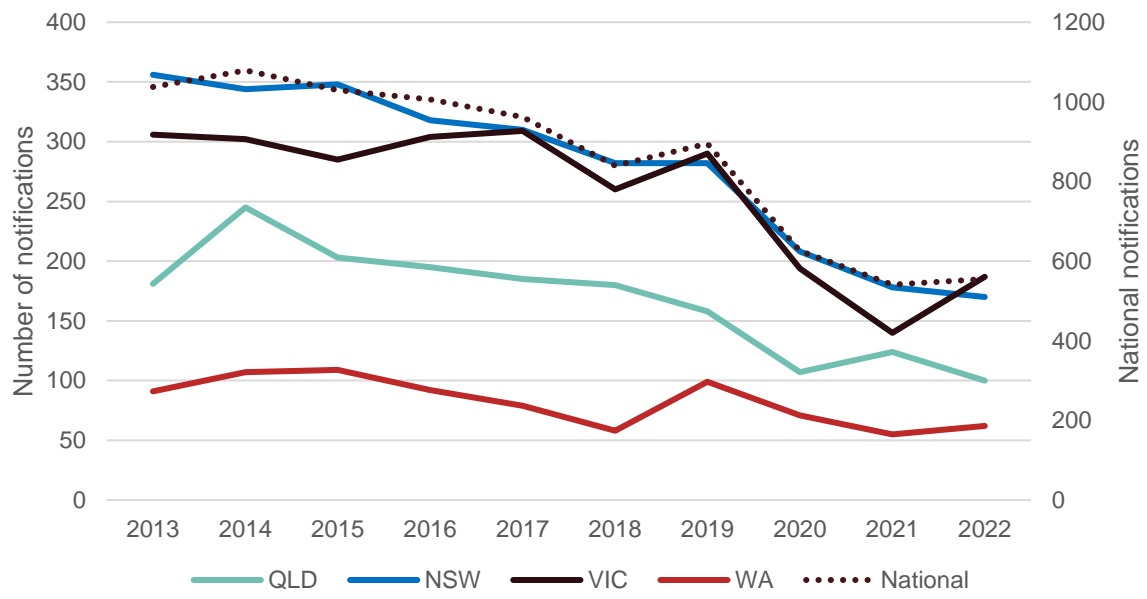


Figure 2: HIV notifications by gender, 2013 – 2022

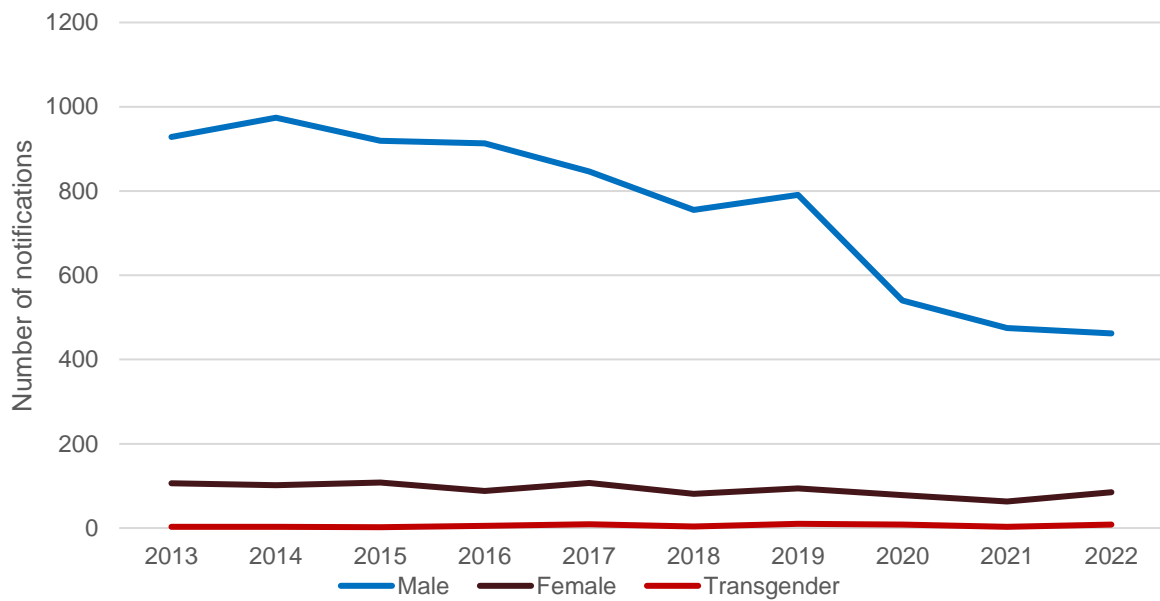


Figure 3: HIV notifications by age group, 2013 – 2022

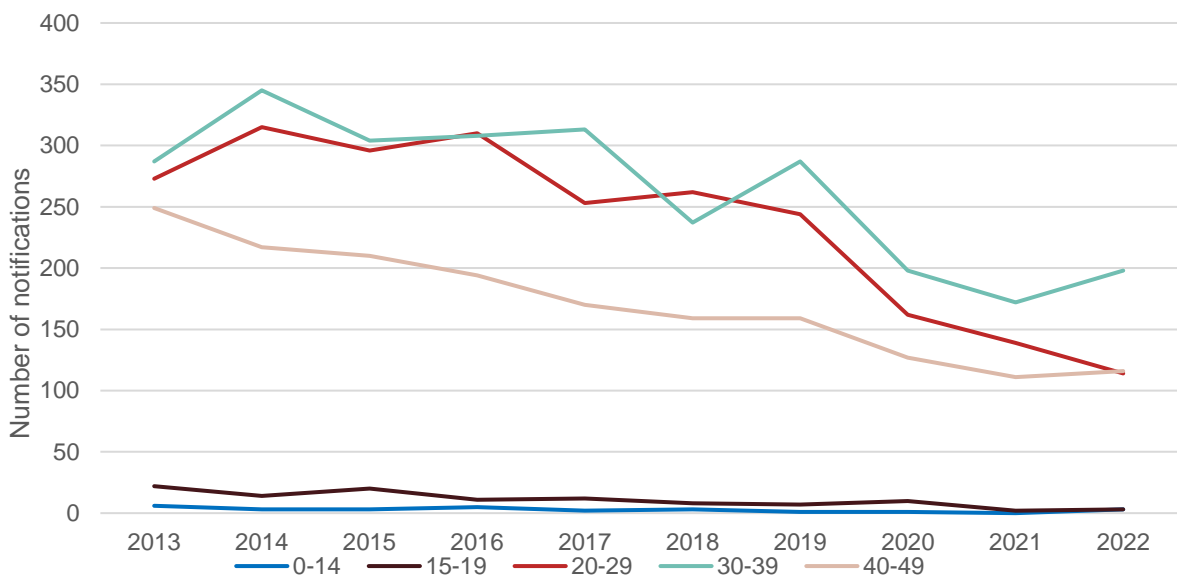


Figure 4: HIV notifications among Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, 2013 – 2022

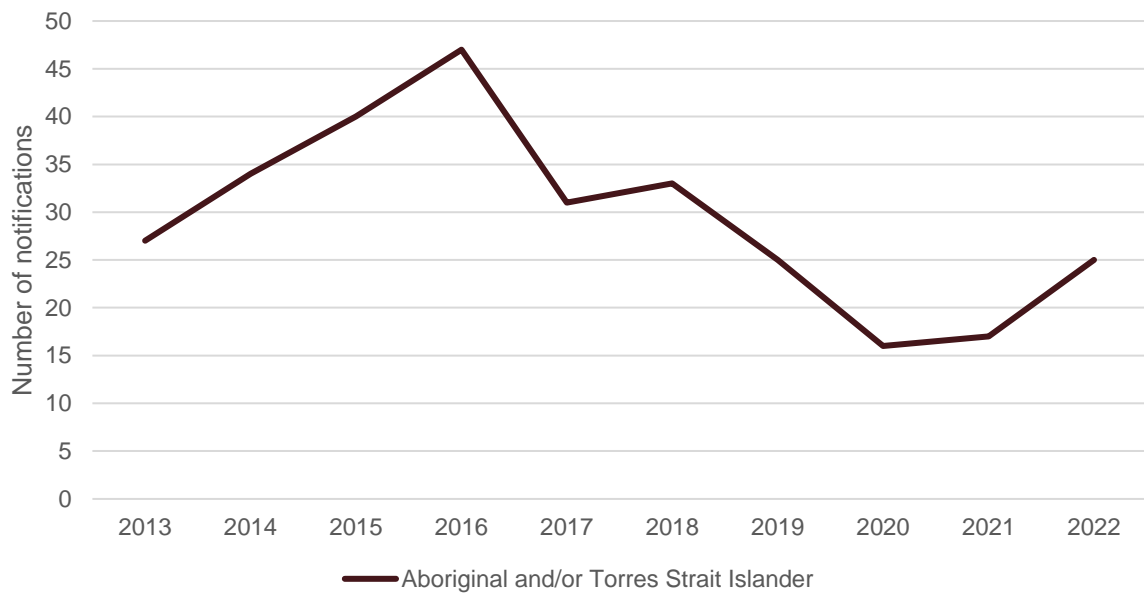


Figure 5: HIV notifications by exposure classification, 2013*

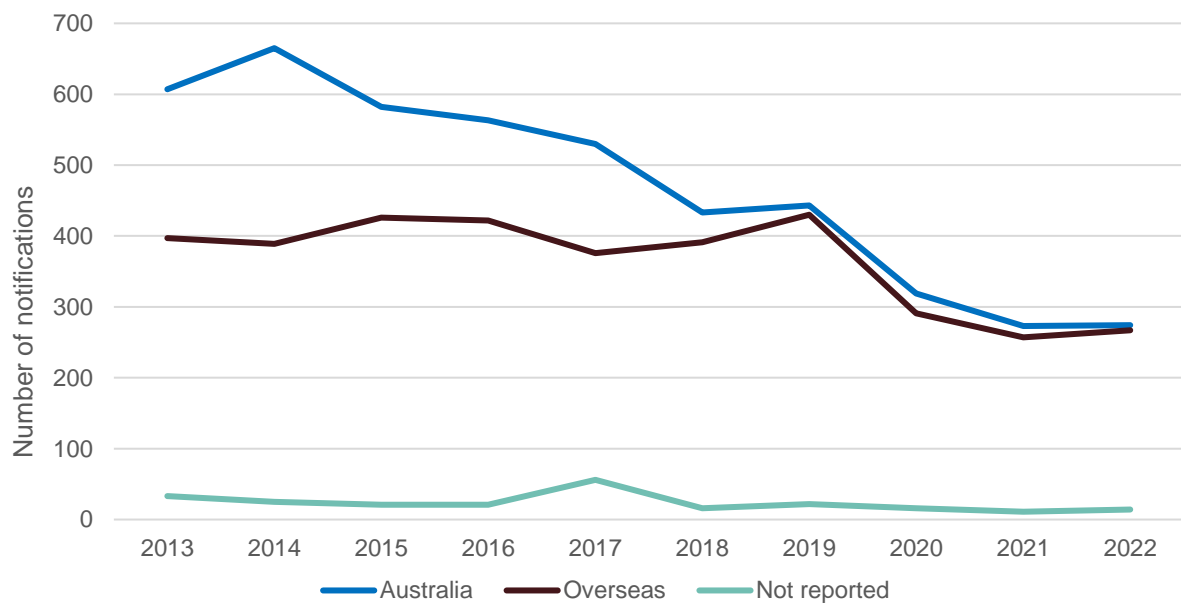


Figure 8: HIV notifications by place of birth among men with an exposure classification of male-to-male sex, 2013 – 2022
